Bookings

To confirm a reservation a non refundable deposit of \$1500.00 per person must be paid. The balance of all fares is then due by the 21 June 2010. Late reservations cannot be accepted after the final balance date. A maximum of 36 people is set for this tour.

ITINERARY

SEPTEMBER 2010

Tue 21 Depart Perth on Emirates flight to Dubai arriving early in the morning with a transfer to your flight to Venice

Wed 22 Upon arrival into Venice in the afternoon you will be transferred to your hotel by private water taxi. As you travel across the vast amount of water you quickly gain a good understanding of the way Venice is designed. Tonight there will be welcome dinner (B,L,D)

Thu 23 After a good night sleep today your local guide will take you on a walking tour to cover such attractions as St Marks Square and the Byzantine Basilica, lavish Doges' Palace and the Bridge of Sighs. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore Venice on your own (B)

Fri 24 The day today starts with an unforgettable Venetian Lagoon Cruise that will take you out of the Grand Canal and to the islands of Murano and Burano. Glide past the islands of San Giorgio and Sant'Elena, and along the banks of the famous Lido. In Murano watch skilled glassblowers fashion their delicate objects in an age old traditional manner. Then continue on to the fishing village of Burano renowned for its bright pastel coloured houses and for its lace making. Take pictures of the traditional fishing boats still used by the local inhabitants, and enjoy an included lunch. Return to Venice and later this afternoon enjoy a serenaded ride in a traditional Gondola, gliding through centuries old canals, under famous arched bridges and past lavish palaces and quaint piazzas. (B,L)

Sat 25 This morning you can have a leisurely breakfast before your midday transfer to the cruise terminal to board Royal Caribbean International's Splendour of the Seas. After embarkation make your way to the Windjammer for a magnificent buffet luncheon (B,L,D)

Sun 26 After cruising overnight you arrive into Split at 0700. As you are docked you can go ashore and explore this ancient city. Visit the palace and the array of quaint shops inside the walls. The ship sails again at 1500 (B,L,D)

Mon 27 From Split you sail south to the Mediterranean and your first Greek Island port of call is Corfu. Corfu is the most lushly vegetated island of all the Greek Islands and is rimmed with dramatic blue waters and topped with tranquil hilltop villages. The ship sails again at 1600 (B,L,D)

Tue 28 With a midday arrival into Athens (Piraeus) you have the afternoon to explore Athens. You can either do an organised tour or take the train from the Piraeus station to the Plaka or Acropolis. You will need to be back onboard the Splendour of the Seas for a 2000 departure (B,L,D)

Wed 29 This morning you arrive into Mykonos at 0700. Visit the famous windmills and walk through the narrow lanes and the white wash buildings. You may even be lucky enough to see the Pelicans of Mykonos while walking the lane ways. The ship today sails at 1700 (B,L,D)

Thu 30 Today is your chance to go back in time as you arrive at Katakolon which is the home of the original Olympic Games. If that does not interest you then you may choose to simply wander through this quaint little village lined with restaurants and bars overlooking the ocean. All aboard again for the cruise back towards Venice. Tonight will be the farewell gala dinner. (B,L,D)

OCTOBER

Fri 01 Today is your last chance to explore the Splendour of the Seas. It is a day at sea and there will be many activities for you to participate in or simply sit back and relax (B,L,D)

Sat 02 An early arrival into Venice and once you have disembarked your coach will head north towards the Croatian coastal town of Opatija. Once you have arrived at the hotel take the opportunity to walk down to the centre of town which is sure to impress. Being a Saturday you are sure to see the way this town celebrates it's many weddings (B)

Sun 03 Travel north and across the border to Slovenia. You will visit the Postojna Caves which is done in part by train and walking. These caves are believed to be Europe's most extensive and certainly best known. After your caves visit you will travel onwards to Bled arriving mid afternoon (B)



Innsbruck

Mon 04 Bled is one of the most picturesque places in the world. Today you will be taken by a Pletna (wooden row boat) to Bled Island. Spend some time to admire the Pilgrimage Church of the Assumption of Mary where weddings have been held since the 15th Century. After the tour you will have time to walk around the town or lake. Dinner tonight is at the mountain top Bled Castle where the view is simply breathtaking. (B,D)

Tue 05 Sit back and enjoy the ever changing alpine backdrop as your coach heads out of Slovenia and into Austria towards Innsbruck in the Tyrolean Alps (B)

Wed 06 Stroll through the medieval lanes to Emperor Maximilian's Golden Roof. The remainder of the day is free with tonight being an Alpine Folk show with dinner included (B,D)

Thu 07 Your drive today is into the Swiss Engadine. See deep blue lakes, airy larch forests, mountain peaks exceeding 4000 metres and quaint villages with massive white stone houses in the characteristic Grisons style. Then you will descend towards the Italian Lake Como (B)

Fri 08 A day today dedicated to the most famous of the Italian Lakes, Maggiore, with its mild climate and luxuriant exotic vegetation. Enjoy a boat ride to Isola Bella, one of the last privately owned islands open to visitors, to admire Bottomeo Palace. Wander around the beautiful gardens and terraces and visit the local markets. Next travel onwards to the sub tropical resort town of Lugano. Time for some shopping under the arcades of Via Nassa, an espresso on flower-festooned Piazza Riforma or maybe a walk in the shade of Parco Cianti's magnificent old trees. Mid afternoon you will transfer back to Como (B)

Sat 09 All day at leisure to relax or explore this beautiful part of the world on your own. Take a stroll along the lake, visit the 14th Century Cathedral, browse through the shops or just sit on one of the lakeside terraces and enjoy the beautiful views (B)

Sun 10 After a short drive along the shores of Lake Como. Take a scenic boat trip and view the famous gardens of Villa Bardianello and Villa Melzi. Stop in the pretty village of Bellagio and Menaggio for a stroll. Later cruise to Como. As you do view the opulent villas of celebrities including George Clooney and Versace family. There is an organised dinner tonight. (B,D)

Mon 11 An easy drive this morning will take you to the commercial capital of Italy – Milan. Your afternoon walking sightseeing with a local guide starts in the pedestrian area with a visit to the magnificent gothic Duomo. Continue through the glass domed Galleria to the famous La Scala Opera House, then a short walk to the imposing Sforzesco Castle (B)

Tue 12 A free day in Milan today so you can explore or shop on your own. There will be a farewell dinner tonight (B,D)

Wed 13 Your time in Italy ends today following a transfer to the airport for your flight home. You depart Milan at 1530 on Emirates EK94 to Dubai arriving 2325 (B,D)

Thu 14 Following a change of aircraft you board Emirates EK420 at 0235 arriving into Perth at 1725 (B,L)
