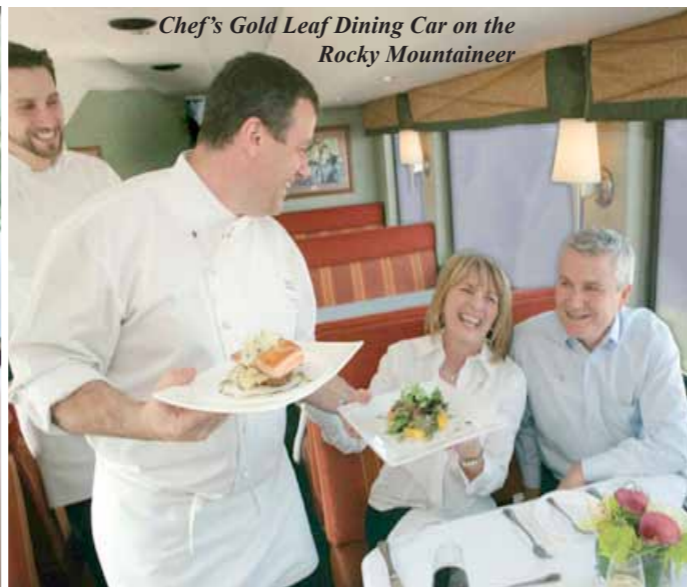

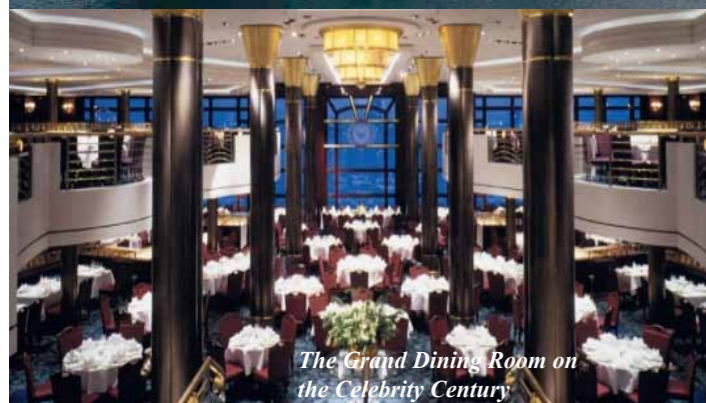


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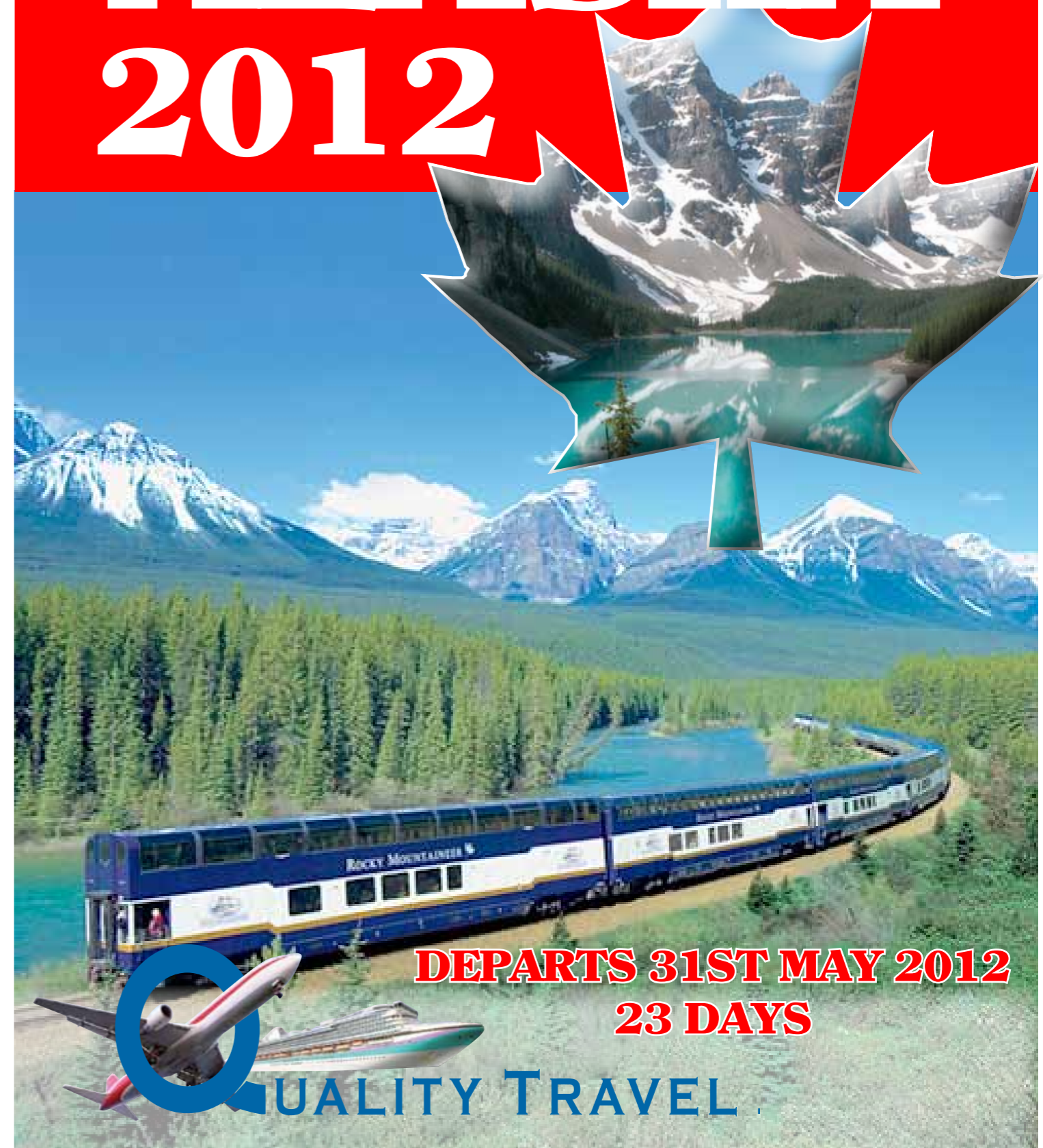

ITINERARY MAY-JUNE 2012

May

- Thu 31 Depart Perth on Cathay Pacific at 0005 to Hong Kong.
Upon arrival Hong Kong at 0755, there will be a transfer to the Holiday Inn Golden Mile (or similar) with the remainder of the day and evening is free.

June

- Fri 01 A midday transfer to the airport to board Cathay Pacific CX838 to Vancouver arriving into Vancouver at 1320. Following arrival formalities you will be transferred to the Fairmont Vancouver . This evening we will meet for a welcome drink and your tour Director will prepare you for the adventure ahead (B)
- Sat 02 This morning tour Vancouver including the waterfront, Chinatown, Stanley Park plus the Bloedel Floral Conservatory at the beautiful Queen Elizabeth Park. The remainder of the Day is free (B)
- Sun 03 Today is the day that we commence the cruise with a transfer at midday to the cruise terminal to board the Celebrity Cruises Century. The accommodation onboard is in Concierge Balcony Staterooms. The ship departs Vancouver at 1630 (B.L.D)
- Mon 04 A full day of cruising the inside passage. Take the opportunity to explore the ship and keep an eye out for marine life (B.L.D)
- Tue 05 At 1500 we arrive at the old salmon processing village of Icy Straight Point (Alaska). At times you will feel you have stepped back in time. All aboard for our departure at 2200 as we head further north (B.L.D)
- Wed 06 Today will be one of the highlights of the Alaska cruising experience as we will be cruising in front of Hubbard Glacier. Watch and hear the large cliffs of ice break from the face of the glacier into the sea. Also again watch for the wildlife as the ship carves its way through the shallow ice (B.L.D)
- Thu 07 An early morning arrival at 0730 into Juneau the capital of Alaska. Apart from a walk through the main street be sure to visit the “Red Dog Saloon”. Departure from Juneau is at 2000 hrs (B.L.D)
- Fri 08 Having cruised overnight we arrive into Ketchikan (Alaska) at 1400. Ketchikan is an amazing fishing village and probably most recognized as the place that the John West adverts were made. Be sure to explore little shops along the boardwalks. Departure is at 2030 hrs (B.L.D)
- Sat 09 Time to head back towards Canada with today another full day at sea cruising the inside passage (B.L.D)
- Sun 10 All good things come to an end with a 0700 arrival into Vancouver with disembarkation by 0930. Upon disembarkation we will be transferred to the Fairmont Vancouver where the remainder of the day is free to explore before we start the next exciting segment of Canada (B)
- Mon 11 It will need to be an early start to board the Rocky Mountaineer (In Gold Leaf). Today we will follow the Thompson River through the beautiful landscapes as we enter the Rockies. Tonight’s stop is in Kamloops and you do not stay onboard the train. Accommodation in Kamloops is arranged by Rocky Mountaineer. Tonight there is a dinner show which we will be attending called Rhythms on the Rails. (B.L.D)
- Tue 12 All aboard again early this morning and as you depart Kamloops you will be served a hearty breakfast. Today’s journey takes us eastward to Shuswap Lake and onwards to Kicking Horse River passes and over the Continental Divide to Banff. Upon arrival Banff we will be transferred to one of the most famous hotels in Canada the Fairmont Banff Springs where we have valley view rooms. Arrival at the hotel will be approx 1830 with the evening free (B.L)
- Wed 13 Following breakfast enjoy a morning sightseeing tour that will take in a ride to sulphur mountain on the Banff Gondola, a scenic drive around Tunnel Mountain where each corner brings a new surprise

– from animals like Elk & Deer to the unique landscape features of the Hoodoos and Bow River. This afternoon is free time so you may like to take a walk through the colorful streets of Banff (B)

- Thu 14 Today we make a relatively short trip to Lake Louise. En route we will take a side trip to see one of the crown jewels of the Rockies _ Moraine Lake and the Valley of Ten Peaks. Here, 10 mountain peaks soar above 10,000 feet and surround the tranquil waters of the lake. Later we will arrive at the enchanting Lake Louise where we overnight at the beautiful Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise in lake view rooms (B.D)
- Fri 15 Travel the awe-inspiring Ice fields Parkway past towering peaks and immense hanging Glaciers to Jasper National Park. View Sapphire Peyto Lake, ride and exciting Ice Explorer on the 1,000 foot thick Athabasca Glacier and see the thundering Athabasca Falls. Your overnight in Jasper is at the Sawridge Inn. There will be time to explore a little of Jasper before dinner. (B.L.D)
- Sat 16 Departing Jasper, watch the scenery unfold while travelling the Yellowhead Highway along the Fraser and Thompson Rivers. This is the same route followed by the early fur brigades of the Hudson’s Bay Company as they paddled fully laden canoes to the Pacific Coast. Pass regal Mount Robson at 12,972 feet, it is the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Accommodation tonight at the Delta Sun Peaks Resort (B.D)
- Sun 17 A spectacular day lies ahead. This morning travel past some of the most beautiful and rugged lakes and mountains in British Columbia. This afternoon we will arrive into Whistler and overnight at another famous Fairmont Hotel. (B)
- Mon 18 Today, Victoria awaits. Departure will need to be prompt and on time as we travel from Whistler to board the BC Ferry for a picturesque cruise to Vancouver Island and the charming “very British Garden city” of Victoria. Following check in at the Grand Pacific Hotel we will have a farewell dinner at a local restaurant (B.D)
- Tue 19 Today we visit the world famous Butchart Gardens. This amazing display of flora spread over 55 acres has different gardens – Japanese, Italian and English style. The estate offers over 700 varieties of flowers. Lunch will be in the gardens and after returning to Victoria the remainder of the day and evening is free (B.L)
- Wed 20 A slightly earlier start today to ensure we make the ferry crossing to Vancouver International airport for the return flight to Hong Kong. Departing on Cathay Pacific at 1450 and arriving into Hong Kong at 1855 on the 21st (B).
- Thu 21 Upon arrival into Hong Kong we will be transferred to the Holiday Inn Golden Mile and the evening is free.
- Fri 22 The morning is free until departure for the airport for the Cathay Pacific flight to Perth departing at 1455 arriving into Perth at 2235 (B)
